SUBJECT: Athena email communication to UGA-only addresses

Implementation of the new Athena system, which replaces the University of Georgia's legacy student systems (admissions, registration, student records, curriculum, financial aid and student accounts), has presented a number of opportunities to improve business processes. To simplify processes that include e-mailing students, faculty and staff, and to remove the effort needed to synchronize e-mail addresses between Athena and UGA's Identity Management System, a new Athena Email Policy will be followed effective August 1, 2014.

The new Athena Email Policy states that email communication <u>from Athena</u> will go **only** to official UGA email addresses (UGAMail). The preferred external email address for faculty and staff will not be used <u>by Athena</u>. University policy does permit UGAMail to be forwarded to another email address (http://eits.uga.edu/email_and_calendar/office365/faculty_staff_email).
