SUBJECT: Long Distance Authorization Code Changes Effective September 1, 2012

Over the past eighteen months, the campus community has provided tremendous support in the implementation of the new telephone system. This support has helped to ensure that as a campus we have a state of the art telephone system with improved features which have not been available in the past. One of these improved features is increased reporting capabilities based on extension. Due to this new functionality, the long distance authorization code (GIST code) will no longer be required when making long distance calls on the Athens Campus. This change will be effective September 1, 2012.

Key Highlights:

- The new telephone system provides a detailed method of tracking all calls, long distance or local, by extension number.
- Departmental Telephone Representatives will have the capability of reviewing these call logs by extension to recognize any abuse that might be occurring via a requested report to Telephone Services by 9/1/2012 and in real-time by logging into the system directly after 1/1/2013.
- Departments can request to prevent the ability to make long distance calls from a specific phone (e.g., public access lines, abuse cases, etc.) by contacting Telephone Services.
