Beginning with August payroll, participants will be allowed to direct their 457(b) contributions to either the traditional pre-tax account or the Roth post-tax account. The Roth account provides the option of having current contributions taxed now instead of having withdrawals taxed at retirement.

Distributions are tax-free, provided certain requirements are met Unlike the Roth IRA, there are no income limits for participation Contribution and catch-up limits are higher than those of a Roth IRA If they qualify, employees may also contribute to a Roth IRA
