eResearch Portal for Grants and Awards Goes Live June 10, 2013

The new eResearch Portal for Grants and Awards ("eResearch Grants") goes live on June 10, 2013. On this date, users can login to this new system using MyID to submit proposals of all types to Sponsored Programs. This new system will also handle all electronic grants.gov submissions to federal sponsors. Cayuse424 will remain active until June 30, 2013.

Beginning July 1, 2013, Cayuse will no longer be available for access, and the use of the new eResearch Grants portal will become mandatory. Also, after June 30, 2013, the online transmittal form will no longer accept new entries, as the eResearch Grants portal provides this functionality as well.
