eResearch Portal for IRB (Click IRB) Goes Live May 30, 2013

The new eResearch Portal for Institutional Research Board (IRB) goes live on Thursday, May 30, 2013. This portal for submission and processing of human subjects research protocols has been in limited deployment for several weeks and will be available for general use on that date.

Beginning May 30, 2013, *only* the eResearch Portal for IRB can be used for submissions. Paper submissions will be accepted through close of business on Monday, June 3. (See important note below regarding continuing review and modifications.)

 the Click IRB implementation, please contact the Human Subjects Office (HSO) at irb@uga.edu or 706-542-3199
 before you attempt to create the submission. To facilitate this process, HSO staff will update the existing
